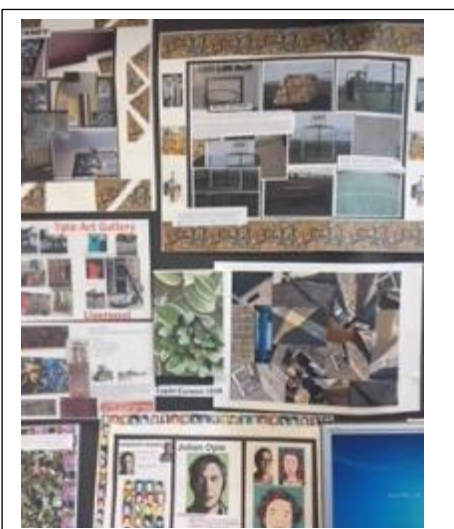
**STEM** – KS2 had a fantastic time with STEM, making and programming Robots and much more
