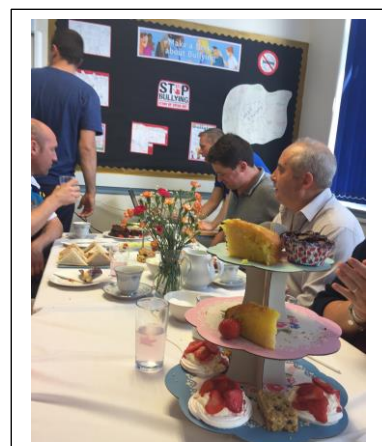
## What went Well:
